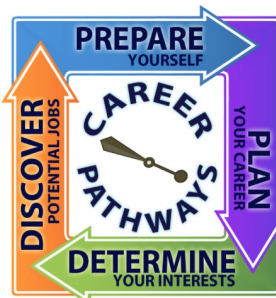
Registration open through November 12th
