A runner-up will be selected to receive the scholarship if the winner does not matriculate at an accredited college during the 2023-2024 academic year.

Instructions for Completing Application

- The completed application including the essay must be sent to the following email address: DBLinks.Scholarship@gmail.com by April 3, 2023.
- Late applications will not be accepted. Winners will be notified by April 28, 2023.
- Applicants will be judged on scholarship, extra-curricular activities, civic/community service, leadership, resourcefulness, and essay (technique, originality, and creativity). The applicant must have a minimum **3.0 GPA**, which must be verified by a copy of a current transcript submitted with the application.
- In addition to the information requested in the application, applicants must submit **two letters of recommendation** from responsible persons, other than relatives, who are well acquainted with them.
- The application must be **typed or neatly handwritten** in ink and must be **signed** by the applicant. Additional sheets of white paper may be used if necessary.
- **Pages should be numbered**. The application face page is the first page. Please be sure to place the question topic next to information on additional sheets.

Topic 1: Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?

Topic 2: What do you consider to be the single most important societal problem as a person of color? Why?
